


### Positive Behavior Support - school wide BobLight System

### **Envision Mathematics**


 \* Monday-Thursday nightly Homework review from the day's lesson

# Literacy




\* Reach For Reading Literacy Curriculum spelling, phonics, grammar, vocabulary and reading curriculum

## Literacy - Daily Five

\* Helps build independence in learning, reading and writing




\*Students choose the order they will complete tasks

\*At this time, students also come to the "teacher table" for guided reading instruction

\*Students complete the "Daily 5" each day

- Read to Self
- Read to Someone
- Listen to Reading
- Word Work
- Work on Writing



#### Homework

\*Math: Homework Monday-Thursday (review of what was learned in class), 15 minutes max


\*Nightly Reading: Every night

\*Spelling Tests: Starting in October. Practice the words throughout the week, test is on Friday.

#### Parent Expectations




\*Read to or with your child on a regular basis

## Snacks and Birthdays




\* Peanut free and healthy snacks please.
